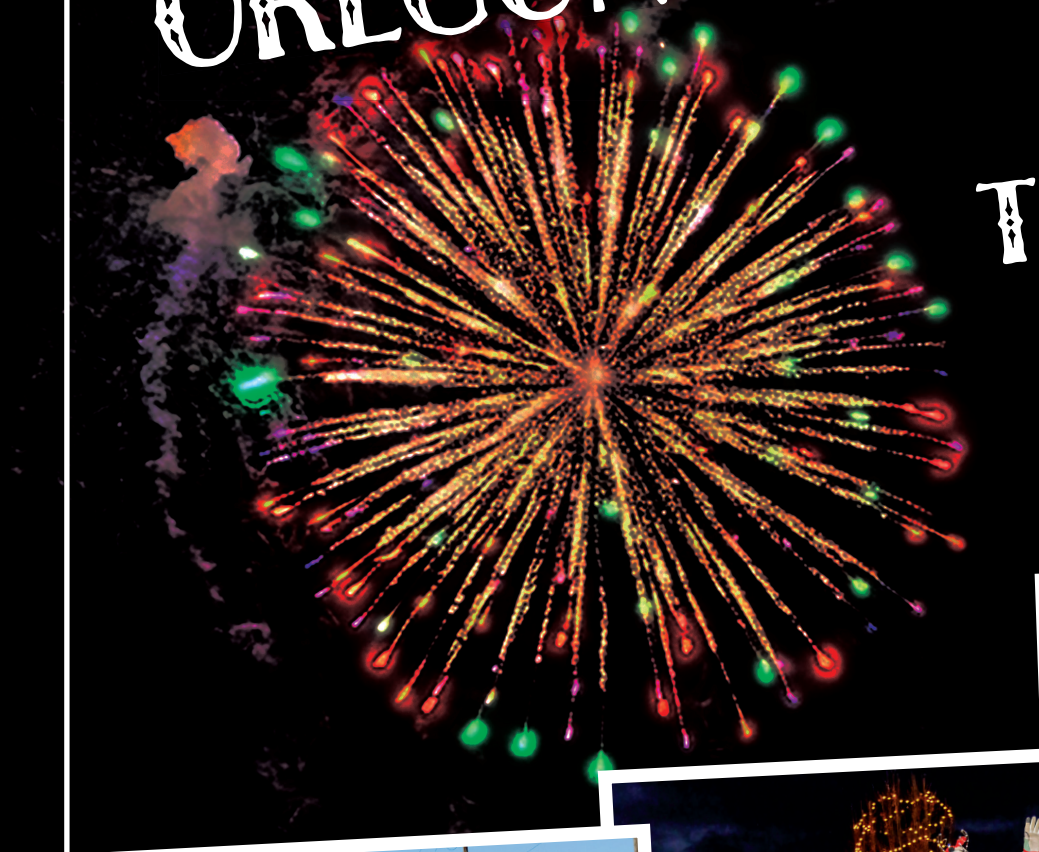

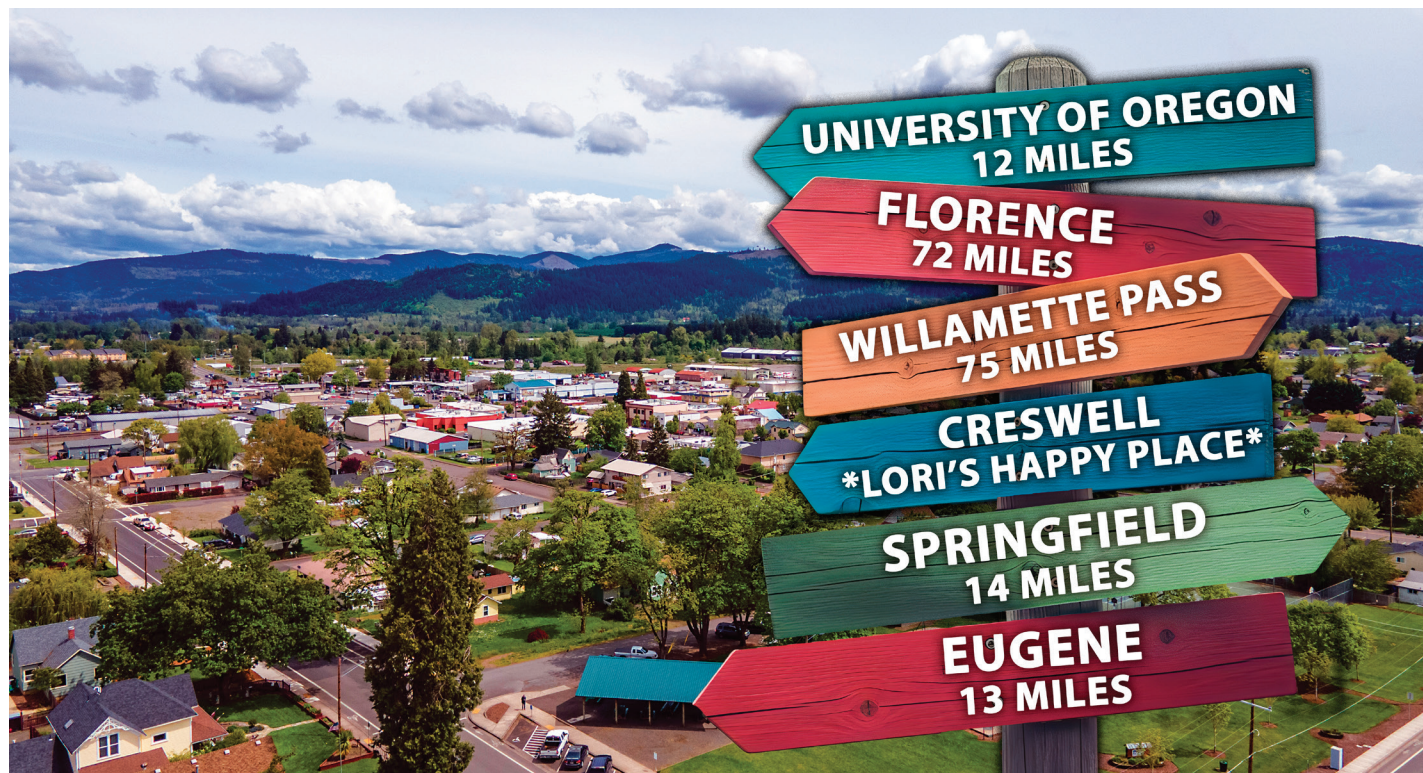

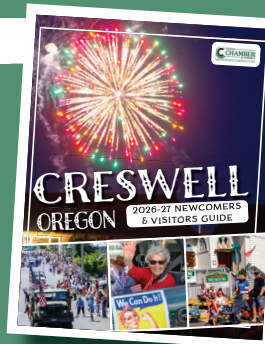

A MESSAGE FROM MAYOR NICK SMITH

It is my honor and a true blessing from God to welcome you as your Mayor in Creswell. I was born and raised in this community, and now I have the privilege of leading this town that helped shape the person I am today.

Welcome to Creswell, Oregon, famously known as "The Friendly City." Nestled in the Willamette Valley, just 10 miles south of Eugene, our town is an important part of "Track Town USA." Creswell offers the perfect blend of small-town charm and easy access to metropolitan amenities. Some even call us the "Paris" of the central Willamette Valley.

The Kalapuya people settled this land long before the city of Creswell was named. Our city was named after our first postmaster, John Creswell, on March 4, 1873. In 1872, Alvin Hughes and James Robinett each donated five acres to help map out Creswell. In honor of these early settlers, a local park was named Robinette-Hughes Park in 2025, attracting youth during the summer with its fun splash pad.

As we approach 250 years of freedom, I want to extend my gratitude to those who have fought and died for this country. Many brave men and women have walked our sidewalks, and as I reflect on their sacrifices, I feel humbled. We must honor them every day! We are not free without our devotion to our flag. In that spirit, Creswell has a vibrant community that hosts many events recognized throughout the state, including an amazing 4th of July celebration by the Creswell Chamber of Commerce. This event honors our soldiers and features a parade, a military flyover, live music, food trucks, park events, a home run derby, and an extraordinary fireworks show in the evening. It's truly an experience unmatched anywhere in America!

We also organize the Winter Lights Festival, drawing people from outside the city for a parade, food trucks, homemade goods, and Career Technical Education products made by our local high school students. Hot cocoa and cider are served by city staff in front of City Hall. Another big attraction is our famous Citywide Yard Sale, perfect for thrifty shoppers and antique enthusiasts seeking treasures. All these events are led by our dedicated Chamber of Commerce, which works tirelessly to promote our city and its business owners.

Creswell proudly hosted its first-ever rodeo on the 4th of July 2025, an impressive event by Creswell's own Hell on Hooves Tour, which is returning in 2026! "Creswell, let's rodeo!"

For visitors, Creswell Airport provides easy access and offers free flights for kids during special events. If you're looking for a bite to eat followed by



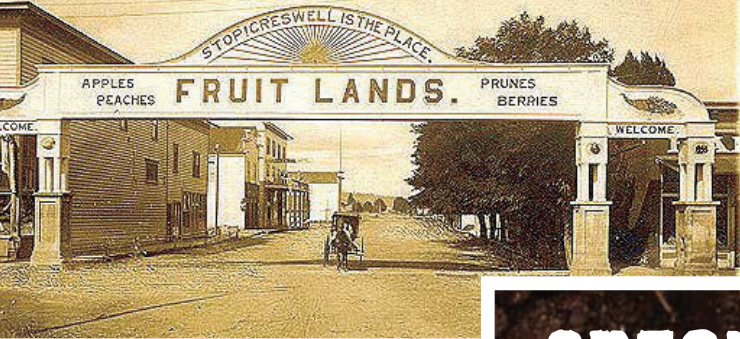

CRESWELL'S RICH HISTORY grew from its fertile land

In the mid-19th century, Euro-Americans poured into the Willamette Valley, taking advantage of the rich lands. Elijah Bristow claimed the first land in Lane County, near present day Pleasant Hill. Other settlers quickly followed, claiming what they viewed to be the best property. In 1850, the Donation Land Act formalized and encouraged settlement in Oregon. The act granted 640 acres to each married couple who lived on and cultivated their claim. In 1857, the first schoolhouse in Lane County opened – a small cabin near the Bristow residence where students were taught by W.W. Bristow, son of Elijah Bristow. Shortly after the school opened, the first church was constructed nearby.

Before long, towns dotted the landscape of the upper Willamette Valley. The original site of the settlement of Creswell began a few miles east of present-day Cloverdale. By 1852, John Gilfrey operated a general store in Cloverdale and a post office served the surrounding community. When the plans for the location of the Oregon and California Railroad became known, many of the Cloverdale community moved west, across the Coast Fork of the Willamette River to a spot that railroad reached by 1871. In this year James Robinett and Alvin Hughes donated land to plat a town. In 1873, Ben Holladay of the Oregon and California Railroad named the town Creswell, after the U.S. Postmaster General at the time, John Creswell. Euro-American settlers in the area relied on agriculture and timber to make their living and the small town plugged away.

The period from 1870 to 1909 saw gradual growth, with Creswell expanding

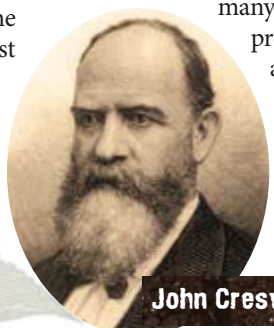
to around 500 people. In 1873, the citizens of Creswell built their first church. Although the building was constructed to serve a Methodist congregation, multiple denominations held services in the building. In 1874, Creswell built its first public building, a schoolhouse, that would later also house the public library and Creswell Civic Improvement Club. Alvin Houghes donated the land for the school and C.P. Curren served as the first schoolteacher. The two-room school building reflected the growing population and the need for a spacious building. The building served as both the schoolhouse and a community gathering place where Christmas parties, Grange meetings, and band practices were held. To accommodate the growing population, Creswell built a new schoolhouse, and in 1900, the First Baptist Church of Creswell bought the original schoolhouse building.

In 1909, A.C. Bohrnstedt, an enterprising businessman from the Midwest, came to town and helped initiate what is known as the Bohrnstedt Boom. Bohrnstedt saw the agricultural potential of the Creswell-area and bought 1,400 acres of

land, creating the A.C. Bohrnstedt Orchard Company. He then ordered 40,000 fruit trees to be planted that winter and made room for 77,000 more trees in his nursery. Bohrnstedt then began to advertise his land to investors in the east. For example, Bohrnstedt brought “excursion trains” of interested people to Oregon, with many passengers later buying property from Bohrnstedt and staying in the Creswell area. The Creswell Development League also helped to publicize by publishing a promotional booklet in 1909 touting the fertile fruit and nut land that surrounded Creswell. This booklet proclaimed,

“It (Creswell) is a wide awake, bustling little community of about 500 in inhabitants and with an assured future...” By the end of 1909 Creswell’s population of 500 had increased 35 percent, and Bohrnstedt predicted the population to reach at least 1,200 by 1915.

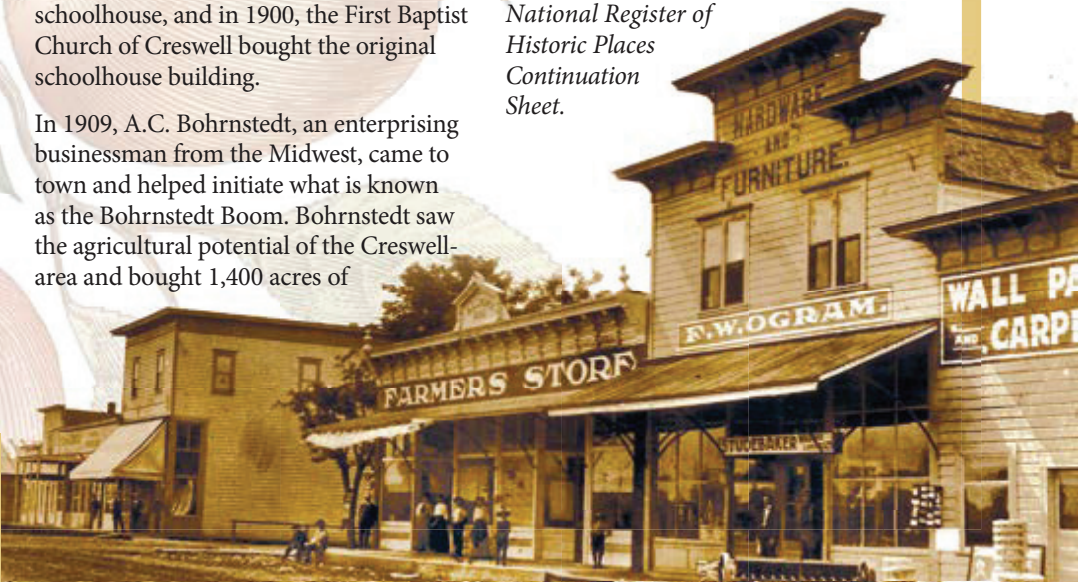

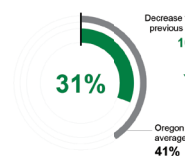

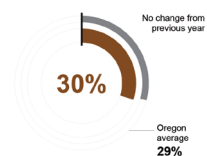

Students meeting state grade-level expectations.

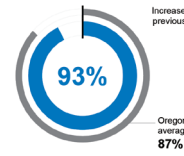


Grade 8 MATHEMATICS
Students meeting state grade-level expectations.

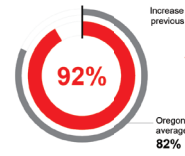

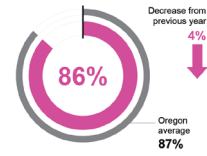
ON-TRACK TO GRADUATE
Students earning one-quarter of graduation credits in their 9th grade year.



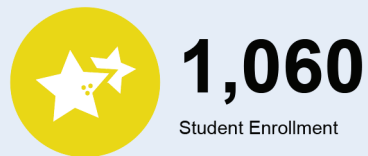
ON-TIME GRADUATION
